



Application for Life Member/Retired Member Status

Life Member

A Life Member shall enjoy all privileges of Active Members and shall not pay dues and will pay a reduced registration fee for the Annual Meeting. Those applying for Life Member status must remit dues through the year in which they apply.

- Active members may apply for life membership upon reaching the age of 65 and paying Society dues for 30 years.
- Active Members may apply for life membership upon completion of 35 dues-paying years.
- Life membership may also be granted by achieving life membership in the AAOMS.

Retired Member

Retired membership shall be granted to an Active, Associate or Affiliate Members should the Member completely retire from the practice and/or teaching of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. Retired Members may not vote or hold office in the Society. A Member granted retired status shall not be responsible for dues, and will pay a reduced registration fee at the annual meeting. Those applying for Retired Member status must remit dues through the year in which they apply.

- Retired Member: Completely retired from the practice and/or teaching of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery.
