# CONTINUING EDUCATION



Jasjit (Jas) Kaur Dillon is a Professor and Program Director of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the University of Washington, Seattle, USA. She is also the Chief of OMS service at Harborview Medical Center; the only level I trauma center in the Pacific Northwest where she has a busy oncology, trauma and reconstructive practice. Her clinical training has been garnered from 5 countries – the UK, South Africa, Hong Kong, Vancouver BC, and San Francisco. She obtained her dental degrees from the University of Newcastle Upon Tyne (BDS), the University of California San Francisco (DDS) and her medical degree from St Bartholomew's School of Medicine, University of London (MBBS). She is a member of the Royal College of Surgeons of England (FDSRCS), the American College of Surgeons (FACS) and is a past examiner for the American Board of OMS. She has over 100 peer reviewed scientific publications, book chapters and lectures nationally and internationally. She is the recipient of two major grants studying medication related osteonecrosis of the jaws – one of which she received the Stephan Milam award for the highest scoring grant in 2016.

## OBEAM Course Information

The AAOMS National Simulation Program allows participants to practice and master critical techniques for administering and monitoring office-based anesthesia. The purpose of the Office-Based Emergency Airway Management (OBEAM) module is to provide information to improve patient safety by understanding the human factors associated with patient safety, basic principles of crisis management as it relates to leadership in a crisis and specific models for managing crises in your office setting that will be practiced through simulation.

During the two-hour OBEAM module, participants review and practice concepts and skills for sedation monitoring

and techniques for supplemental oxygen, opening an airway, bag-valve-mask (BVM) ventilation using one- and two-handed techniques, laryngeal mask airway (LMA) insertion and use of the Airtraq laryngoscope for endotracheal intubation. Ventilation parameters are manipulated so difficult BVM can be practiced and mastered after mastery of BVM in a normal configuration.
